In the beginning of the scene, lady macbeth is presented as Nasty as shown when she says "The raven himself is hoarse". This suggests the raven will give so many warnings about death. The word 'death' also suggests lady macbeth might die. A contemporary audience may have thought lady macbeth has a lot of power. A modern audience may think lady macbeth has a lot of power. Shakespeare lived in a patriarchal society so he made lady macbeth more powerful. Further on in the scene, she is presented as evil because she makes an evil scene in Act 1 scene 4 when she says "leave all to me". The audience gets the impression that she's very brave.
