In the elegy, as imperceptibly as grief Dickinson masterfully dictates the passing of time in the exposition of the poem with the quote 'The Summer lapsed away'. At first glance readers may feel she is watching the time pass by through her isolation, yet, on closer analysis it could be analysed as her hinting about her grief slowly fading away. Similarly the quote 'as twilight lag

begin' may give readers
the impression that
she is in a distraught
state as ~~the~~ 'twilight' is
a short lived moment
but for her it is 'long'
also indicating that time
is passing slow for Dickinson.
This is further reinforced
by the quote 'The dusk
drew earlier in'. Literally
the quote implies the days
are getting shorter as the
season is passing. Symbolically
it could imply that her
grief is leaving her
quicker. This could link
to how for her whole
life she has been surrounded
by grief and death.
