September	Bronze Assembly Presentation & Silver Meeting – Letter & email home

19 th October	Silver Training Walk (Saturday morning) – team-work, equipment, route-planning, navigation, safety, Countryside Code.

January	Students must have started their 6 month Activities and should now be deciding on any remaining Activities.
By Easter	First (three month) Activities completed and all Activities commenced.

April & May	Bronze & Silver after school training sessions to cover:-
